## Tobyhanna Army Depot 100th Anniversary Open House

Saturday; June 23rd 0900-1630

We have received notice of an Open House to be held at Tobyhanna Army Depot June 23rd to celebrate their 100th anniversary as an installation. The installation will be open to the public with many attractions besides the opportunity to see the equipment our workers repair and fabricate.

Their program calls for the Army's Golden Knights to parachute at 1000 and 1400; a Car Show; Children's Carnival; 5K run; Historic Military Vehicle and Equipment Display; Entertainment; Food Beverages and a special Steamtown run to Tobyhanna.

The last time they had an open house they had near 10,000 people attend the event. The event organizers will allow vehicles and equipment to arrive on the 22nd 0900-1900 and egress to the site the following morning at 0530-0830 to set up displays and equipment. There will be a parade starting at 1530 and ending at 1630. All equipment must be removed no later than 1500 June 24th. There is on site security coverage.

I am in the process of obtaining more information regarding this event and I will include additional information as it becomes available. Rules for entering the base are essentially the same as at Fort Drum last June. If you have any questions please let me know.

**Members present; VP Matt Magda and wife, VP Messersmith, President Fairfield, Grady Scott, Bob Sokol, Mark Snyder, Alton Diehl, and Lance Robson.**

**Meeting called to order at 1310 by VP Messersmith who led the group in the Pledge of allegiance. Introductions followed.**

**VP Messersmith asked for any corrections to January 29, 2012 minutes as printed in "NY-PENN NEWS". Motion to accept minutes as printed, Accepted.**

**Treasurer was absent and had given information to President Fairfield to report; One check written, \$150.00 for yearly club insurance. This left a balance of \$8236.57 as of February 1, 2012**

**President Fairfield explained in general what insurance covered and passed around a written summary of coverage, provided by insurance company.**

**Correspondence: Invitation from member Dick Blunden for car show at Norwich this year.**

**E-mail invitation to attend Tobyhanna 100 year anniversary Saturday event. Tours of base are possible.**

**Old Business: Talked about Fort Drum event, they are working on a tour of some base operations this year in place of trail ride. Everyone enjoyed last years weekend.**

**President Fairfield said board is trying to locate a central (to all companies) location for a NY-PENN picnic. Lance Robson said he and some others have been looking for a central location to no avail. The central area is mostly farm land with a few small public parks that are not suitable for our club. The Executive Board is also considered a rotating club picnic between the three company's. This would provide a short drive once every three years. President Fairfield has offered to host a two day picnic this year at his property in conjunction with a local ice cream festival. More info. at March meeting.**

**President Fairfield mentioned NY-PENN donation to USS Slater and asked about other donations to flood victims. A number of members questioned if these worthwhile donations are within clubs objectives. VP Messersmith read clubs purpose from By-Laws. "to promote member collection, restoration and preservation of military vehicles and history to educate the public".**

**Members said Executive Board should consider clubs "purpose" before approving any donation.**

**President Fairfield reported progress on erection of a durable fence and marking of a Revolutionary War soldier's grave near his home. Members thought it was a good project and if it did not fit within clubs "purpose" maybe A Co. could underwrite expenses from donations.**

**New Business: Lance Robson said from attending shows he has noticed that military ownership is changing to younger vehicle owners (under 55) that have newer vehicles and like to drive them on the road. In order to attract new members we will have to change some of our thinking on type of events we provide.**

**President Fairfield said we currently have about 80 paid members and a few years ago we were approaching 150 members. Some member decline is related to death as members from WW II, Korea and even Vietnam are approaching 70+ in age.**

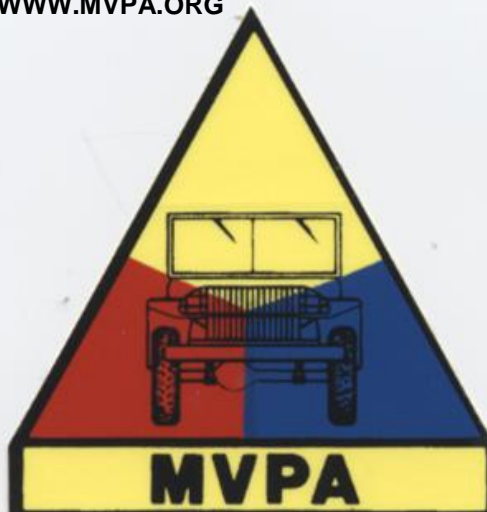
