The membership was asked to consider attending next summer's VA carshow as was done in 2010. No date set at this time. The money raised goes to the patients at the VA for personal needs. John Nichols thanked the club for the past 7 years of being a member and serving the club. John Nichols turned the meeting over to the incoming VP 1, Jack Pollard and incoming VP 2, John Tennis, at 1:31 PM. Jack gave his Inaugural address and got right down to business:

Item 1) The HM Chapter, Easy Company, and The Binghamton Chapter all all equal parts of NY Penn and that is the way we want to keep it

Item 2) He would like to go back to the way members can speak about any new MV purchases during the past month and then donate \$1 to the club for each new vehicle. A motion was made by Greg Wolanin, seconded by Don D'Ambro, and carried by the members.

Item 3) He would like to restart the auctions of items donated by members with proceeds going to the club treasury. A motion was made by John Powell, seconded by Greg Wolanin and carried by the members with 1 no vote

Jack opened the floor to the members for new business and Greg Wolanin brought up the Veterans Day Parade on 11/11/11 at 11:11 as being a very Historic event that will see a



very large turnout, including National Guard people and MVs, and that we will probably have police escorts to help with traffic and parking.

Greg Wolanin also informed the members that the MVPA seriously wants to hold the 2014 National Convention on the East Coast, and is working with Redball of PA to host it at Tobyhanna Army Depot. Greg asked that NY Penn send a letter of support to Redball, offering both people and MVs to help the

It will be forwarded to NY Penn board of directors to be approved and carried out.

Jack read an email from Larry Bush of the Cobleskill AMVets, asking NY Penn to attend their Memorial Day parade with as many vehicles as possible, it was discussed, including conflicts with other parades that day, and left up to the individual members to attend if possible. No motion was made, no vote taken. John Tennis said he will attend with one vehicle. The parade is May 30th at 10:00 AM. Jack delegated VP 2, John Tennis to be the auctioneer at each meeting. The board of Directors now have the Corporate Books and Seal, at a cost of \$130, which has been paid. An IRS tax form will need to be filled out and submitted for 2010. Paul Blanchet asked where and how to pay his dues, Jack told him he could pay right at any meeting and it would be noted and sent to NY Penn treasurer.

Tim Ryan asked about a current membership list with status of member's dues being shown and Jack told him it would be ready very soon.

Jack pointed out that members with internet access should receive the Newsletter by email in order to save on printing costs and postage, it was discussed. It is a valid point and deserves consideration by the membership

John Powell asked if any members who are also Steel Soldiers, could have their "handle" included on the membership list to help us connect members to their handle. There was a discussion, and the topic was tabled for future consideration.



Here is a captured NAZI Germany V-1 "BUZZ BOMB" which was used to terrorize the residents of England, and London in particular during WWII. Eventually the Allies developed fighters fast enough to intercept and shoot these down. The V-1 would fly on a pre-determined path and when the fuel ran out would crash on what was hoped to be the intended target.



Here is a rare preserved example of the Infamous German '88' Artillery piece.

Originally designed as a high velocity antiaircraft weapon, its ability to depress the muzzle below horizontal made it extremely versatile and this was used extensively as an anti-tank weapon. So effective was this design that this gun is still in use in several nations as a tactical field gun.
